

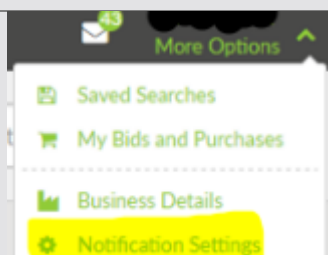
In this update:

- Time zone setting is now available – Have you set yours?

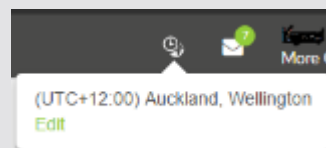
Saved Searches can now be your default search

Do you want to find products quickly?

Now you can save a search and set it as your **default view**.

Each time you go to the Listings page the filters will be set automatically

You can also receive a notification when listings match the search criteria. Your criteria may be any of the filters, such as products, type of listing or approval status.

How to set up a Saved Searches:

1. Use the filters and sort options to select your search criteria.
2. Click on the icon ‘Save This Search’ and give your search a name.
3. Select the frequency you want to receive notifications (daily, every 3 days or weekly.)
4. Set one search as your default view

All about: Notifications

Notifications are sent to buyers to inform them about listings.

Notifications can be turned ON or OFF by managing your settings.

1. Go to **More Option**
2. Select **Notification Settling**
3. For each notification listed **tick or un-tick** the message and delivery method

If you have never **logged in to GDT Marketplace**, you will not receive notifications about the listings you are approved for.

To date all dates and times have been shown in UTC.

You can now set your **local time zone**, which will update all dates and times on GDT Marketplace to show the time zone you have set for your account.

Once set the following fields will show your local dates and time

- Trading Start and End times
- Time Left

How do you update your time zone?

1. Click on the **clock icon** (located next to the message envelope icon)
2. Click **Edit**
3. Click the drop down box next to **Time Zone**, select the right time zone for you.
4. Select **Save**

The default time zone setting will be UTC
