



To date all listings have been in USD*.

As more sellers offer more products to more markets, so does the need to offer listings in other currencies. Currencies that are local to the buyers.

- **The currency and price is set by the seller.**
- **The buyer bids and purchases in the same currency.**
- **Successful sale will be executed in the currency set by the seller.**

Note:

Contracting Information will remain in USD until early July.

We will keep you informed on this change.

Buyers do not have the option to purchase in a different currency, from the one the seller indicates on the listing.

*The default currency still remains USD

Setting your local time zone

See listings in your local time zone, by updating your

1. Click on the **clock icon** (located next to the message envelope icon)
2. Click **Edit**
3. Click the drop down box next to Time Zone, **select the right time zone** for you.
4. Select **Save**

Once set the following fields will show your local dates and time

- Trading Start and End times
- Time Left

The default time zone setting will be UTC

Do you want to know more information about why your bid on a tender listing was unsuccessful?

GDT is going to provide information to you when your tender bid is unsuccessful due to price.
